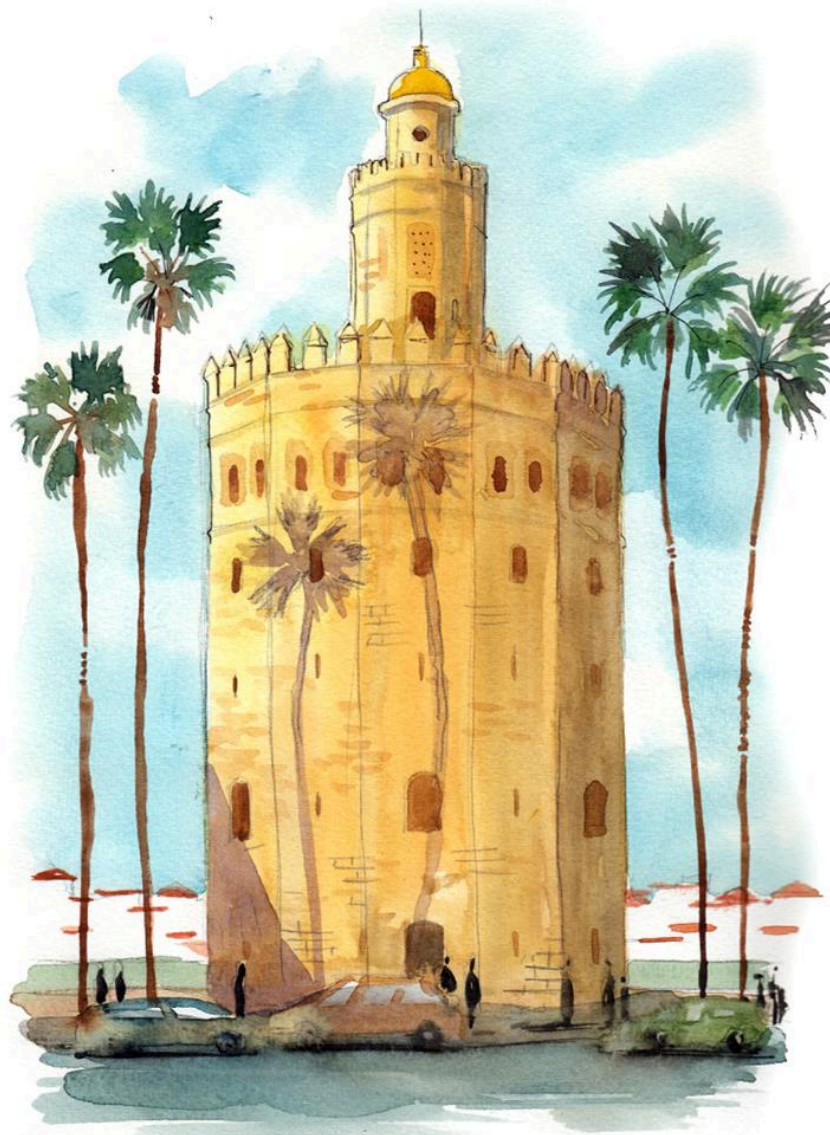

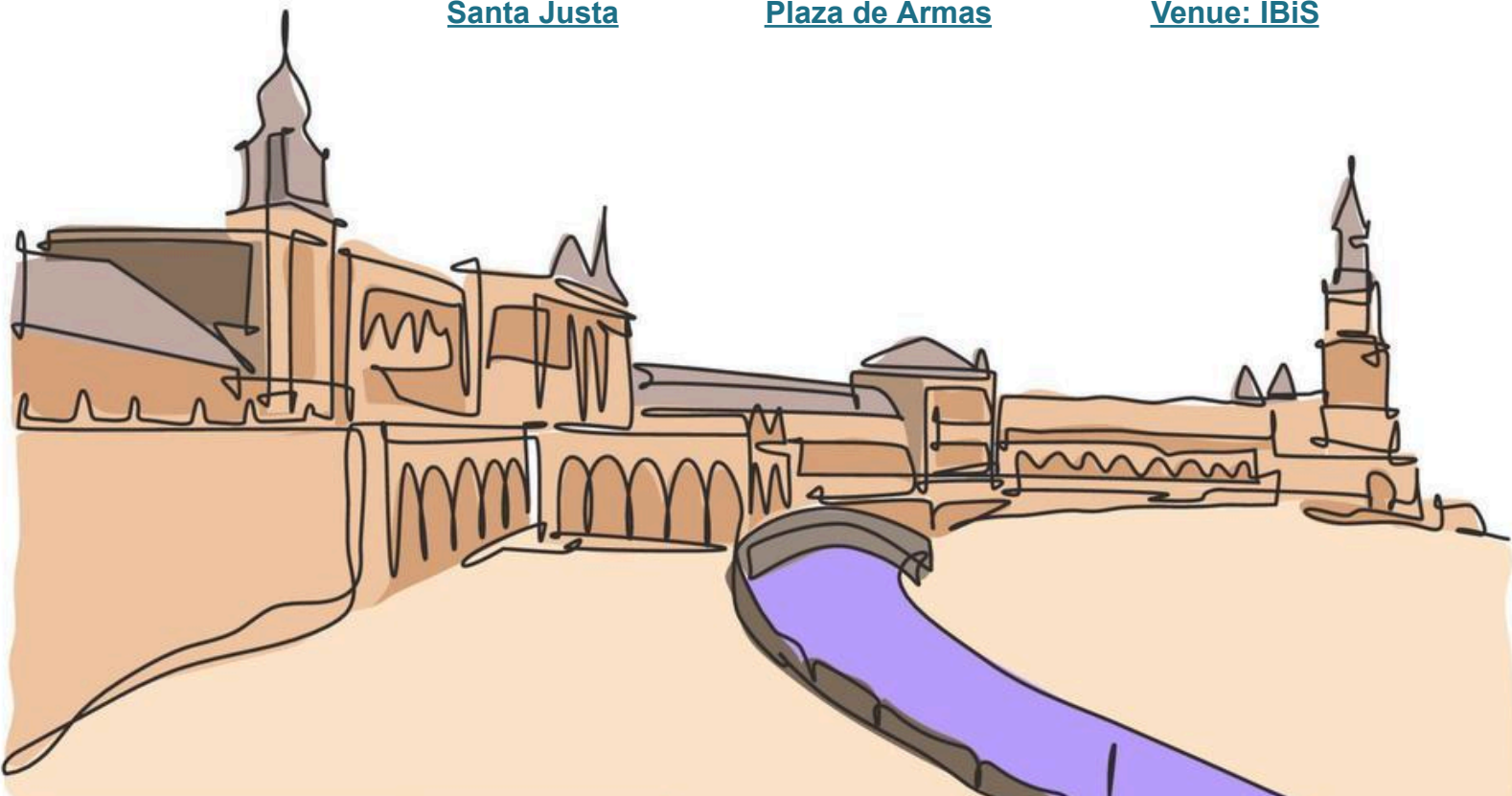

## 4. Social event and dinner

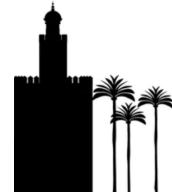
### ➤ Transfer from the venue to “Torre del Oro”

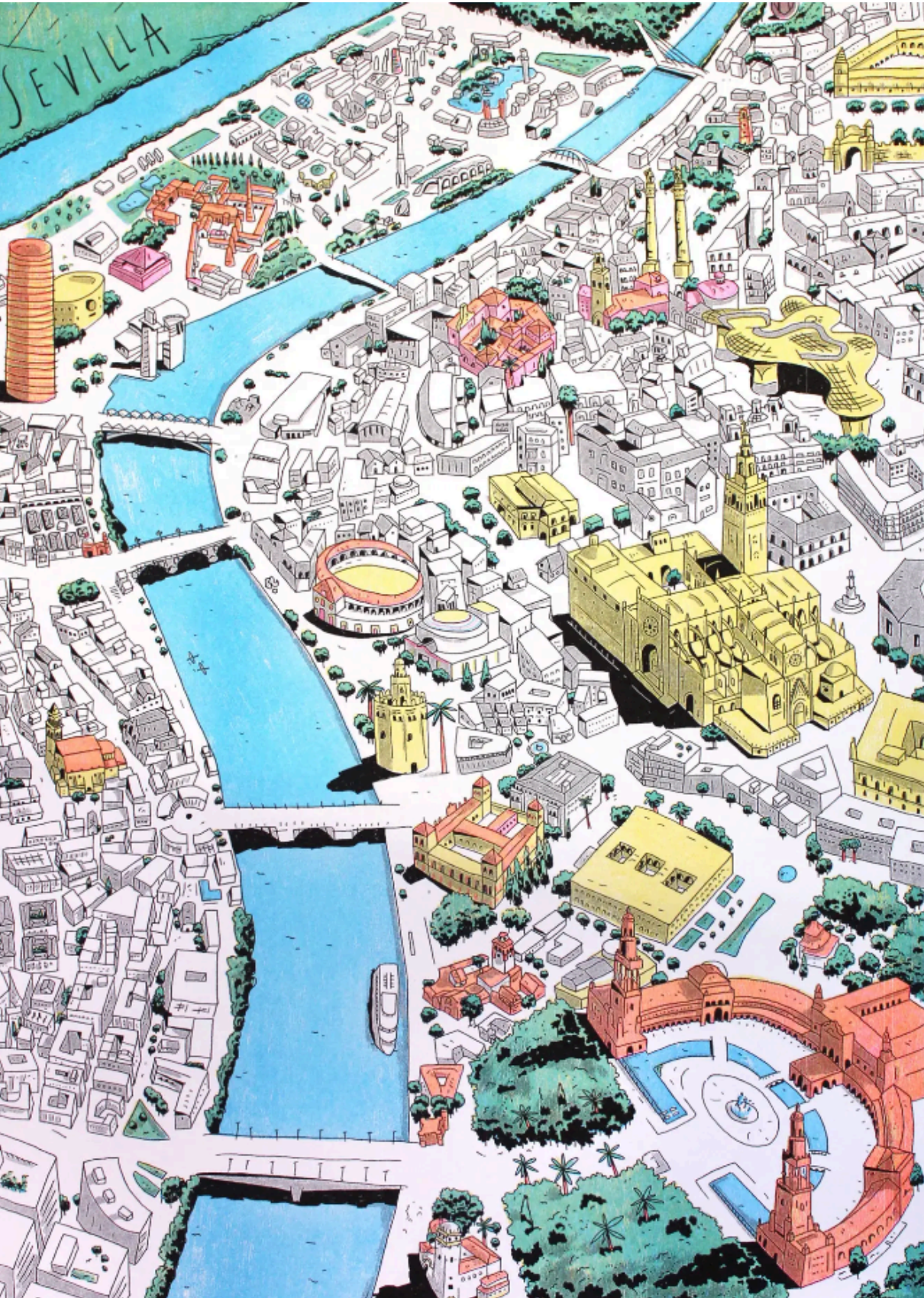

## 7. Recommendations

### Things to consider for the meeting:

- To access the building you will need to identify yourself. Please, bring your ID card or similar.
- Coffee/lunch breaks are not allowed inside the building, so during these breaks we will have to go to the building next door to enjoy coffee or lunch.
